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# Tips, Tricks and Gadgets

## Swipe

*With your finger on the screen, quickly drag your finger to one side or the other of the screen to view the next screen.*

## Getting to your Home Screen

*Press the menu button once. This is a good place to keep the apps you use most often.*

## Searching for an App

*Press the menu button once from the home screen. Your cursor will be in a search box. Type the name of the app and click the search button on the keyboard. Select the app/person/item you are looking for within your search.*

## Updating Your Apps

*Select the App Store. Select Updates at the bottom of the screen. Select the update button. NOTE: make sure you are connected to wireless.*

## Creating and Naming a folder

*Hold down the App until it starts to giggle. Select 2 Apps you want to reside in the same folder. Drag one of the Apps on top of the other. You will see a black outline around the App. In the white area above the Apps select the title and add/delete or change the title to whatever you want to call the folder. Select the menu button to stop the Apps from giggling. To take an App out of the folder reverse this process.*

## Delete an App

*Hold down the App until it starts to giggle. You will see an "x" in the left top corner of the App – click the "x" and select the Delete prompt from the pop up window. Select the menu button to stop the Apps from giggling.*

## Adding an App to the Dock

*Hold down the App until it starts to giggle. Select the Apps you want to reside on the dock. Drag the Apps to the dock. Select the menu button to stop the Apps from giggling. To take an App off the dock reverse this process.*

## Setting Bookmarks

*Using Safari, Chrome or other browser click on the*

*icon. Name the bookmark and select the folder you want to save it to.*



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# Tips, Tricks and Gadgets

## Sharing information via email, social networks, and other functions



### Take a Picture of Your Screen (Screen shots)

*Click down BOTH the Sleep/Wake button at the same time. You will hear a camera shutter sound. Open your Photos and you will see your screen shot.*

### Saving Images

*Hold your finger down on an image and select the Save Image button.*

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## OTHER FUN and HELPFUL TIPS

### Force Quit – When your iPad Freezes

*Hold down BOTH the Sleep/Wake button and the HOME button until your iPad turns off*

### Cutsum iPad Wallpaper

*Save your picture >> Settings >> Brightness & Wallpaper >> Wallpaper >> Camera Roll >> pic your picture >> Set \_\_\_ which ever you want >> exit settings*

### Locking the Screen Orientation

*Double press your Home button >> Swipe your finger across the bottom bar >> select the button on the left to LOCK or UNLOCK your orientation*



### iPad Split Keyboard Feature

*Open an App that uses the keyboard >> with your thumbs pull the keyboard apart >> to put it back together use your thumbs to push the keyboard back together*



## **iPhone v. iPad APPS**

*Remember that iPhone Apps still run on the iPad, just at a smaller size!*

## **Save your battery**

*Double click your Home button and hold down one of the icons on the bottom. Click the “-” to close the Apps you are not using. Click the home button again once to close the bottom screen*

## **Change the name of a folder**

*Hold down one of the Apps until they are in wiggle mode. Double click on the folder you want to name. Tap in the name bar and rename your folder. Click on the folder one to close and save the information you typed. Click the home button again once to stop the Apps from wiggle mode.*

## **The Number Slide**

*Tap the numbers key, keep it held down, and when the keyboard changes, slide a finger to the number ( or other character) you want to type. When you lift your finger, the number is typed and the keyboard snaps right back to the letters view.*

## **Special Characters**

*When you touch and hold a letter, any special characters (é) that use that letter will pop up. Slide your finger to the character you want to use, and lift. If you're entering a URL or email address and you see that .com button, press and hold it to access .net, .edu, .org, and .us.*

## **Multitasking Getures**

*Settings > General > Multitasking Gestures and tapping the On/Off switch.*

***Use four or five fingers to:***

- *Pinch to the Home Screen*
- *Swipe up to reveal multitasking bar*
- *Swipe left or right between apps*

## **Speak Selection**

*General > Accessibility > Speak Selection (under Vision)*

## **Speak Selection**

*General > Accessibility > Zoom*

***Zoom magnifies the entire screen:***

- *Double-tap three fingers to zoom*
- *Drag three fingers to move around the screen*
- *Double-tap three fingers and drag to change zoom*

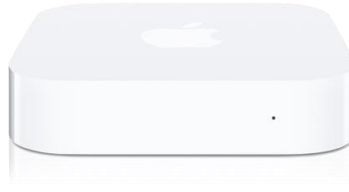
